Affiliation	Players must be financial members of a club affiliated to Bowls Counties Manukau
Availability	Players must be available for the key events that apply to each squad
Commitment	Players must commit to the goals and culture of the squad
Conduct	Players must understand and adhere to the Bowls Counties Manukau Code of Conduct.
Desire	Players must have a strong desire to be involved in representative competition
Fitness	Players must have a level of physical and mental fitness to allow them to play through the key events to the last delivery
Performance	Players will be assessed on current and recent performance at representative and Centre level
Team Balance	Players are required to contribute to overall team performance, team unity is important, and team success is the overall goal
Technique/skills	Players must possess and display the techniques and skills required for representative play
Versatility	Players will exhibit an ability to adapt to conditions and game situations.

How will players be seen?

The different selectors will use a variety of methods to ensure all players that meet the above criteria are seen during match day. Centre events are the key venues where players will be seen playing with and against strong players. Players that are not prepared to commit to playing Centre events may not meet the criteria above. Some club championships and other club events will also showcase a player's ability to compete at a high level.

What is required to increase your chances of being selected?

Playing in centre events, commitment to playing in most events is expected.

Attending practices/training if you are selected in the wider squad.

Practicing and working on your game throughout the season.

Developing your physical and mental fitness.
